GO→SPIN Platform: What is and what's for?

Provides guidance and information resources in support of mapping information on STI policies, national STI ecosystems and their organizations, STI legal frameworks, operational policy instruments and indicators for providing evidence-based policy analyses, policy mix design, access to temporal series of indicators and a set of UNESCO and external databases.

Purposes:

- Facilitate *processes* of learning by broadening perspectives and framing by codifying and ordering the significant, but fragmented, knowledge base around STI (policy) dynamics
- Encouraging intelligent benchmarking
- Supporting international mutual learning and exchange
- But also complementing (and not substituting) existing processes and analysis



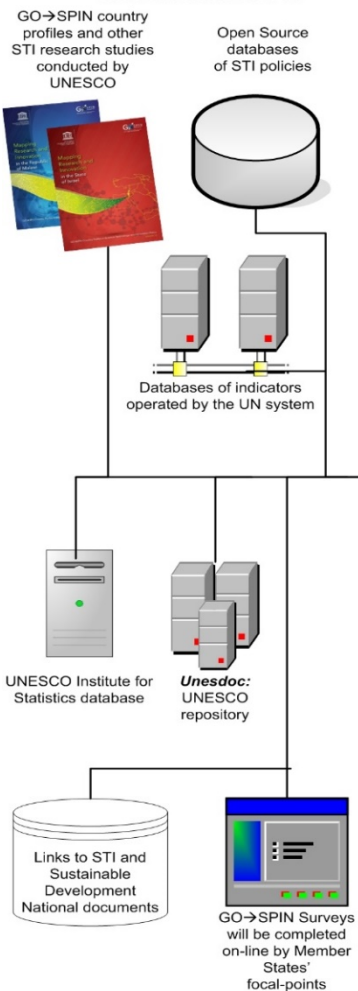
Who are the potential users?

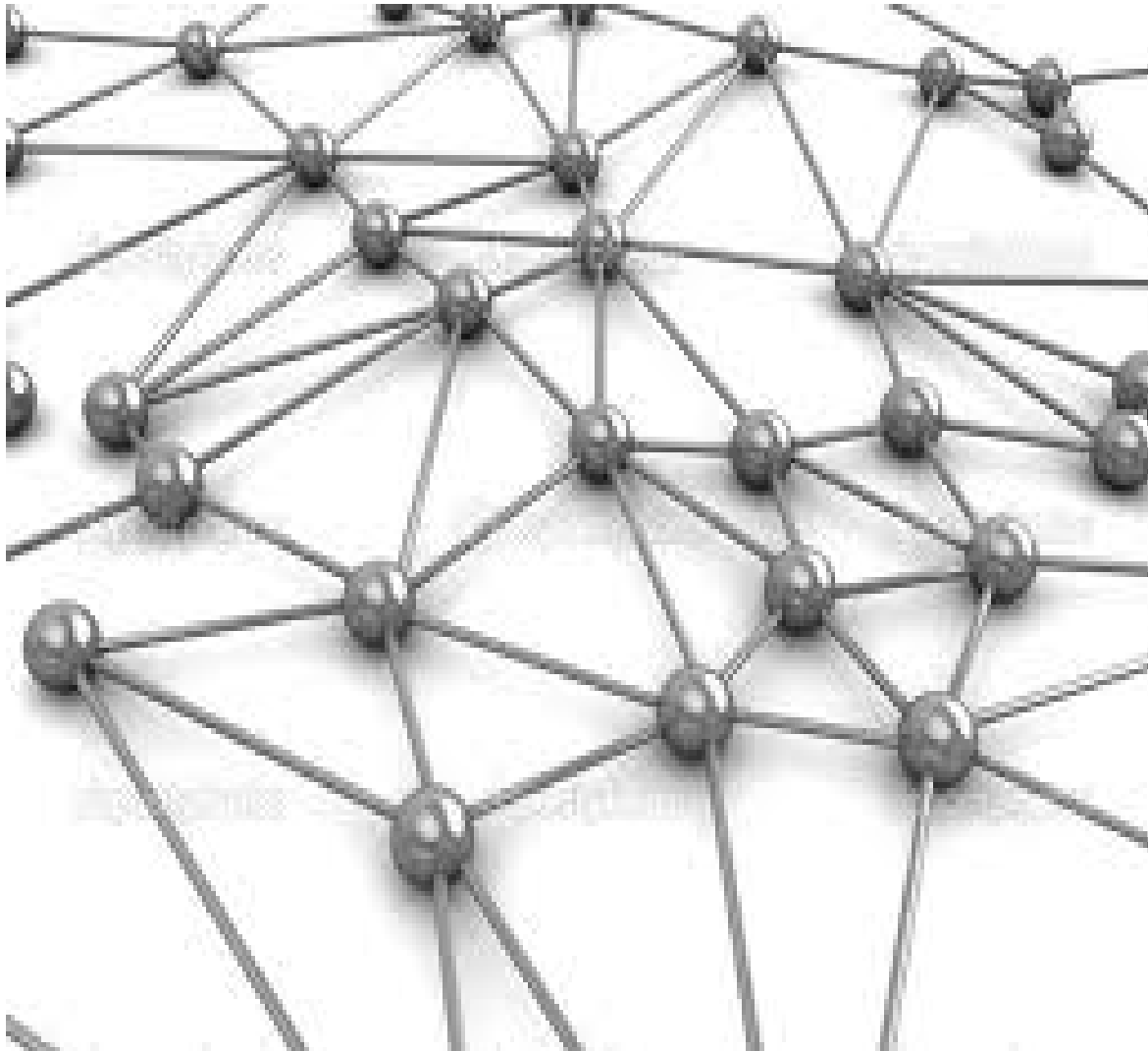


Figure 4.4. Organizational chart showing Kenya's research and innovation system.

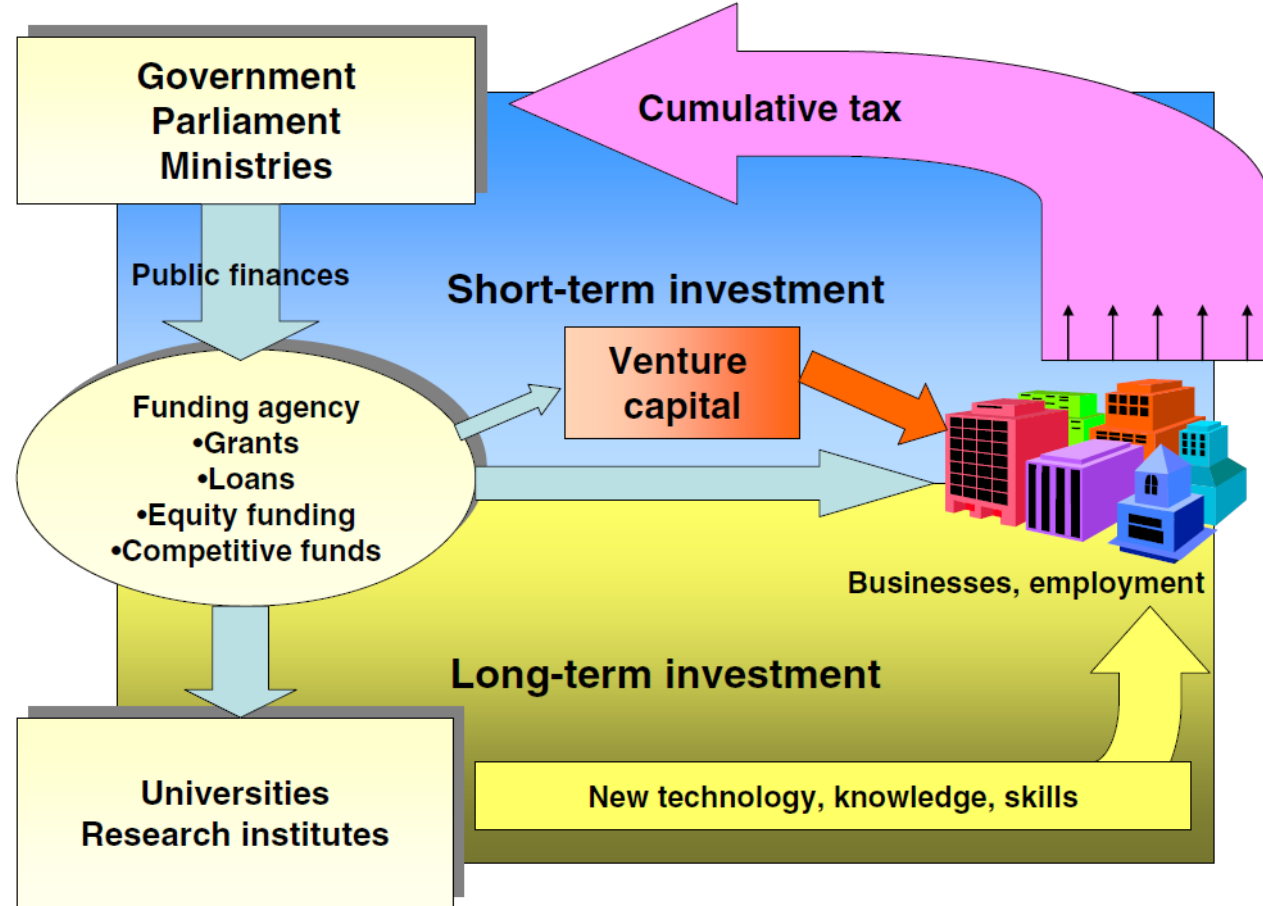
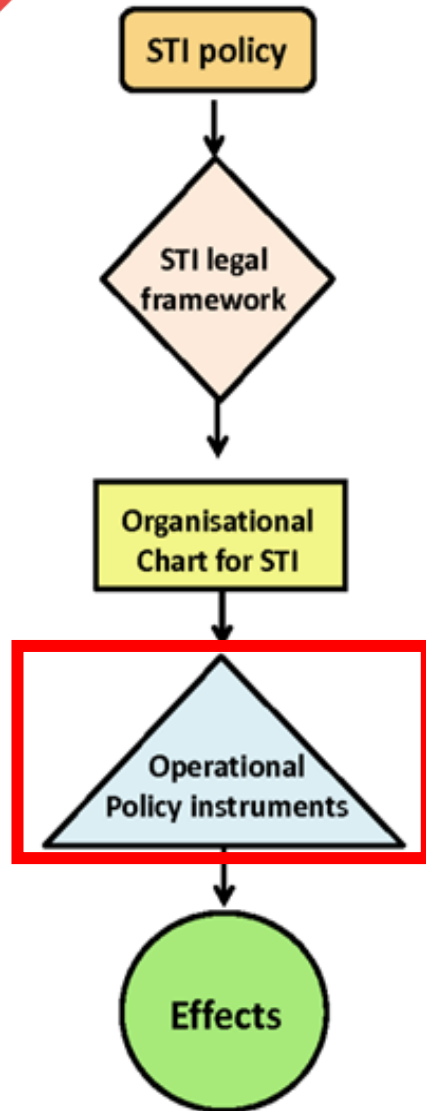

This Program provides partial funding to CONICET Postdoctoral Internal Fellows for short-term internships in research centers of excellence abroad, oriented to carry out training and/or experimentation within the work plan presented. At the time of application and during the entire stay abroad, applicants must be active fellows in the above-mentioned category.

Partial Funding Program for Overseas Stays for Research Assistants

This Program provides partial funding to Members of the Scientific and Technological Researcher Career of CONICET in the category of ASSISTANT RESEARCHER in research centers of excellence abroad, aimed at completing their training, training, experimental training and / or collaborations.

At the time of application, applicants must be active researchers in the category mentioned above.

Objectives of the STI plan

Strengthen fundamental aspects of the National STI system (human resources, infrastructure, organization, procedures, articulation and coordination) in order to provide it with sufficient capacity to meet the productive and social demands as well as enhancing its effectiveness and operational efficiency through the generation of greater complementarities, reducing contradictions and optimizing the use of resources.

Partial Financing Program for Short Stays Abroad for Postdoctoral Scholars

Recipients: Internal CONICET Postdoctoral Scholars who are active both at the time of application and the use of the funding, who may apply for a single period of internship during the duration of the scholarship.

The beneficiaries of Extraordinary Postdoctoral Grants, Special Grants and Postdoctoral Reinsertion Grants, as well as those Internal Postdoctoral Scholars who are enjoying a period of scholarship in addition to the statutory scholarship period, may not participate.

Duration: The periods of stay abroad to be requested may not be less than two (2) months and may not exceed six (6) months in duration. The period of stay abroad must be within twenty-four (24) months of the scholarship award. Postdoctoral Scholars who are in exceptional extensions may not participate.

Academic requirements:

Complete the BIGERH module by logging onto the Intranet of CONICET, taking into account the instructions for carrying out the electronic version of the application. Presenting compliance notes for the completion of the Internship from the foreign institution's authority and the researcher responsible for directing the scholarship holder's activities during his/her stay, with institutional letterhead and corresponding signatures.




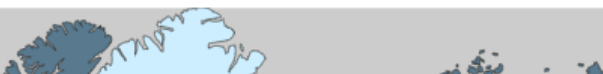
